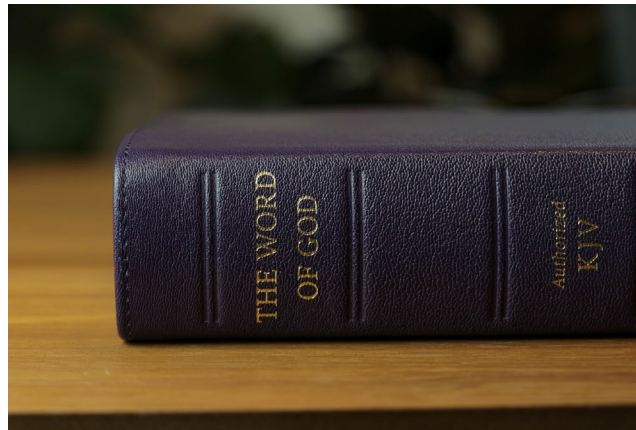

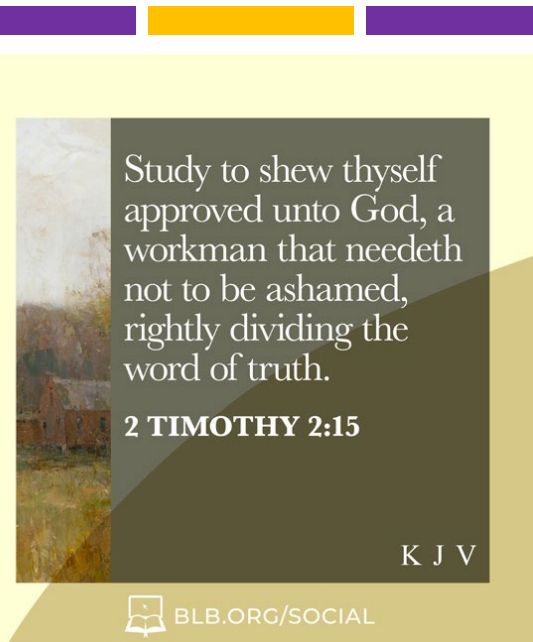




## Who can take ETA?

## What is ETA?

ETA is a Bible based two (2) section course designed to help students further their knowledge of the Bible, and various biblical subject matters. This is accomplished through a survey of the entire Bible, learning the basics of human growth and development spiritually and naturally; including understanding teaching, teaching techniques, and leadership.

Each section of ETA is six (6) months in length with a graduation at the end of section one. A certificate is issued at the completion of each section. The course sections are as follows:

- Section 1- Standard ETA
- Section 2- Advanced ETA

The course is conducted online, similar to a level one college course.
